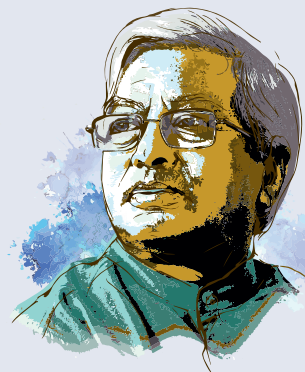




SIR FAZLE HASAN ABED FELLOWSHIP PROGRAMME FOR WOMEN

ABOUT THE FELLOWSHIP

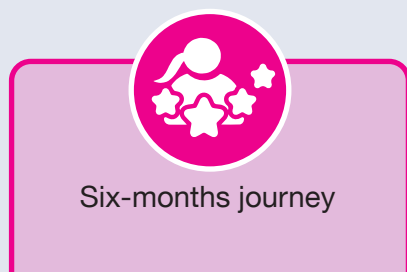

WHO CAN APPLY

- Recent women graduates of Bachelor's programmes in the aforementioned institutions who have completed all credits in or after the year 2022. Final semester students may apply if all credits are completed by June, 2023
- Minimum CGPA- 3.00 out of 4.00 and 3.60 out of 5.00
- Demonstrated leadership experience within university campus/community through extracurricular activities
- Proficiency in English language
